STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION

The <u>CHECKING ACCOUNT BALANCE</u> at the VALLEY NATIONAL BANK was <u>\$ 63,008.49</u>.

The <u>ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLES</u> balance was <u>\$1,361.30</u>. There were no AR items aged more than 30 days.

The <u>OTHER CURRENT ASSETS</u>, (prepaid insurance), includes **GENERAL LIABILITY** coverage for all of 2023 and **LITIGATION** insurance for the protection of the LCCTA's Officers and Board members for the period from 05/16/2023 through 05/16/2024. The balance as of 12/31/2023 was <u>\$1,057.74</u>. This balance will be reduced monthly as premiums are expensed.

The above actions resulted in the **DECEMBER 31, 2023 TOTAL CURRENT BALANCE being \$65,427.53.** The Current Asset balance at this time last year (12/31/2023) was \$66,506.00.

The <u>ACCOUNTS PAYABLE</u> balance was <u>\$802.53</u>. There were no AP items aged more than 30 days. The <u>RESTRICTED Contributions/Donations/Funds</u> balance was <u>\$5,064.09</u>. This total consisted of **\$765.00** for the BILL CARPENTER SCHOLARSHIP FUND and \$4,299.09 restricted for the WHEELCHAIR TENNIS PROGRAMS and SERVICES.

The TOTAL EQUITY BALANCE as of DECEMBER 31,2023 was \$65,427.53. The Total Equity balance at this time last year (12/31/2022) was \$65,406.00.
