TREASURER'S REPORT - OCTOBER 31, 2021

STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION comments;

- The **CHECKING ACCOUNT** balance at the VALLEY NATIONAL BANK was **\$60,342.94**.
- The <u>ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLES</u> balance **\$1,448.80.** There were no AR items aged more than 61+ days.
- The <u>OTHER CURRENT ASSETS</u>, (prepaid insurance) includes **GENERAL LIABILITY** coverage for all of 2021 and **LITIGATION** insurance for the protection of the LCCTA's OFFICERS and BOAR members for the period from05/16/2021 through 05/16/2022. The balance as of 10/31/2021 was \$562.06. This balance will be reduced monthly as premiums are expensed.

The above actions resulted in the **OCTOBER 31,2021 TOTAL CURRENT BALANCE being \$62,353.80.** The total Current Asset balance at this time last year (10/31/2020) was \$57,673.06.

- The <u>ACCOUNTS PAYABLES</u> balance was <u>\$457.68</u>. There were no AP items aged more than 61+ days.
- The <u>RESTRICTED CONTRIBUTIONS/DONATIONS/FUNDS</u> balance was \$12,983.01. This total consisted of \$2,100.00, for the <u>BILL CARPENTER SCHOLARSHIP FUND</u> and \$10,883.01 restricted for <u>WHEELCHAIR TENNIS PROGRAMS AND SERVICES expenses</u>.

The **TOTAL EQUITY BALANCE as of OCTOBER 31,2021 was \$61,896.12**. The Total Equity Balance at this time last year (10/31/2020) was \$56,076.82.
