TREASURER'S REPORT – JULY 31, 2020

STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION comments;

- The **CHECKING ACCOUNT** balance at the Valley National Bank was **\$56,918.29**.
- The **ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLES** balance was **\$1,572.20**. There were no AR items aged more than 61+ days.
- The **OTHER CURRENT ASSETS** accounts include **GENERAL LIABILITY** coverage for all of 2020 and **LITIGATION** insurance for the protection of the LCCTA's OFFICERS and BOARD members for the period from 05/16/2020 through 05/16/2021. **The balance of the OTHER CURRENT ASSETS as of 07/31/2020 was \$906.30**. This balance will be reduced monthly as premiums are expensed.

The above listed actions resulted in the **JULY 31, 2020 TOTAL CURRENT ASSETS** balance being **\$59,396.79**. The Total Current Assets balance at this time last year (07/31/2019) was \$77,163.91.

- The **ACCOUNTS PAYABLES** balance was **\$872.20**. All AP items were aged less than 61+ days.
- The **RESTRICTED CONTRIBUTIONS/FUNDING** account balance was **\$13,123.14**. This total amount consisted entirely of contribution, donations and funds restricted for the use of Wheelchair Tennis programs and services.

The **TOTAL EQUITY BALANCE as of July 31, 2020** was **\$58,524.59**. The Total Equity Balance at this time last year (07/31/2019) was \$77,863.68.
